Regulatory checks were integrated through third-party SOAP and JSON APIs, resulting in reduced registration friction and increased new business.
- **Open Banking Prototype:** Developed an Open Banking prototype using Docker, Drupal 8, OAuth, SwaggerHub, and PHP's Lumen. This prototype securely demonstrated the benefits of Open Banking, allowing clients to integrate their holding information into third-party apps and enhancing the platform's value proposition.
- **Risk Management:** Enhanced the platform's trading capabilities by implementing a compliance-driven questionnaire. Upon completion, users were granted access to trade complex instruments, ensuring adherence to regulatory standards.
